rule our hearts.

Promise: "The one who humbles himself will be exalted." (Lk 18:14b)

Order: Bless the Lord at all times.

Direction:

1. Serve God willingly.

2. Faithfully attend praise and worship.

Week#5 (31st Sunday in Ordinary Time)

Theme: We bear the mark of a true servant of Christ when we repent of our wrongdoing and

make reparation.

Promise: "The Lord is good to all and compassionate toward all his works." (Ps 145:9)

Order: Abandon your wickedness and believe in the Lord.

Direction:

1. Be humble and repent, reconcile and make amends.

2. Regularly receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation.
