# DCS Meeting: July 27, 2016

1. The DCS conducted a debriefing session on the recent Disciples' Assembly, gathering thoughts and reactions and ensuring that the action plans as presented at the Assembly concerning the new BLD Statutes, are carried out.

- a. Cluster Shepherd to send another follow up reminder to
   Archbishop Lagdameo about transmission of the new statutes
   to RCAN, % Archbishop Myers.
   In addition, BLD Newark is awaiting Archbishop Lagdameo's
   response to the various comments and issues on the Statutes, as
   discussed by the Cluster Shepherd and DCS at a meeting in May.
- b. If by August 31, the Statutes have still not been received by RCAN, the DCS will request to meet with the Archbishop or his representative, to present the Statutes themselves.
- c. The Powerpoint presentation made by Manny Mangalonzo was sent via email to the DLC.
- 2. The class of ME42, Shepherds Tony and Tatess Abad, are being assigned to ministries and will be blessed and prayed over on Friday, August 5, along with Marc/Emma Belmonte (Liturgy) and Patrick McGrail, new district instructor.
- 3. There was an extended discussion about problems and issues of the community with our landlord, DMP. This includes venue scheduling, cleanliness and security in the premises.

In this light, the DCS will meet with Fr. Robert Lamirez to present these issues, and discuss solutions, dwelling on provisions in the lease.

- 4. The DCS approved a request for assistance from Noli & Rose Chavez, ME 38, through their class shepherds, Jovy and Emily Lucero, to conduct up to 2 BLD-assisted LSS at the parish of St. Anthony of Padua in Belleville, NJ. With the help and support of BLD's Fr. Dave Sison, and with various parishes in the area, there is the likelihood of a good number of candidates. Afterwards, Evangelization will work hand in hand with Mission in inviting the participants to join BLD's various encounters.
- 5. Although still 2 months away, everyone is asked to save the date for and attend a "Morning of Mercy" retreat sponsored by the Archdiocese of Newark Evangelization Commission to be held at Divine Mercy Parish on Saturday,

September 24 from 9:30-12:30 pm. Receive the graces of the Jubilee Year of Mercy!
