- Paby and Pauline Ibarrola have accepted their new assignment as the new Discipling Ministry Coordinators to carry on the duties and responsibilities previously discharged in faithful and long service by Mon and Bingle Chan, former Mission Stewards. The community blessing for the Ibarrolas was given during the Holy Eucharistic celebration of November 4, 2016.
- 2. As a follow up on our last meeting minutes items regarding -

- a. <u>Community Safety Issue(s) Upgrading and restocking the medical emergency kits:</u> There will also be a consultation with medical professionals on the use of medical equipment especially the defib for emergencies, and for them to help the community to sufficiently address all possible medico legal ramifications; and finally to formulate the necessary protocol, processes and procedures.
- b. <u>Divine Mercy Parish (DMP) repairs (of water-damaged ceiling and electrical lighting in the little kitchen pantry room used by Service Ministry)</u>: Pursuant to the DCS action item, the Management Stewards subsequently met with DMP's Fr. Robert Lamirez. However discussion is still ongoing regarding this concern. Additionally the community will be sharing in the cleaning of the DMP venue facilities in rotation with other groups who are using the same with the assurance from Fr. Lamirez that these other groups will do their own share of the cleaning rotation.
- Status Updates on the preparations for the LSS at St Anthony de Padua, Belleville:
 - a. The LSS lambs' kits have been printed.
 - b. The LSS Orientation has been scheduled for Saturday, November 12 to be followed by the Salubungan immediately after based on the preliminary Shepherds - Lambs matching.
 - c. The site visit by the LSS team will be done during the Salubungan/shepherding.
- The creation of the Advocacy and Social Justice Ministry to coordinate our community's involvement in the 20/20 Pro-Life initiative of the Archdiocese of Newark in cooperation with other dioceses in NJ was discussed.
