5	Appeal to Help Victims of Typhoon Ompong in the Philippines	Last September 15, 2018, fierce winds and heavy rains hit Luzon with the onslaught of typhoon "Ompong," considered one of the strongest to hit the Philippines this year. The aftermath of the typhoon brought about massive destruction – landslides, massive flooding, destroyed homes, damages to infrastructures and agriculture estimated at P21 billion, and death. Affected were 510,000 families (2.1 million individuals). We are appealing to your generosity and compassion to support our Community effort to reach out to our brothers and sisters who are victims of Typhoon "Ompong." Note: we will have a "Typhoon" basket this Friday specifically for this appeal. Your generosity will be greatly appreciated.
