1	Meeting wit Monsignor Schetelick (Discussion		 Protecting God's Children (PGC): Presented the discussions from the previous meeting (April 29, 2019) with Karen Clark, Director, Safe Environment of RCAN: BLD is not under DMP. BLD is an ecclesial community, not a parish. However, BLD members still need to comply with the Archdiocese's Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People. Who should complete these requirements? All BLD members who are actively serving or directly involved with minors (below 18 years old). This includes young adults interacting with minors, especially during encounters & seminars. Mark10, John 6 and Youth ministry coordinators and adult core members Encounter class shepherds (ME, SPE, SE, YE, J6). ***Members must complete the requirements as soon as possible. Below are the 4 points requirements: Must attend the PGC workshop Must sign the Volunteer application Must read and sign the acknowledgement of compliance with the Policies on Professional and Ministerial Conduct, including Archdiocesan code of Ethics (Code of Conduct) 		

	
	 Must submit a Verified Volunteers' criminal background check (cost is \$22.00) and will receive a letter of attestation from Msgr Schetelick stating that he or she passed the background check. PGC guidelines during inter-district conference (different districts from other states and Canada) At least, adult core members need to provide a letter of attestation that they are PGC certified, like a suitability letter for priests. Emil Canlas, BLD Local Safe Environment Coordinator (LSEC), is responsible for keeping copies of all the required documents of BLD members who need to complete the four points requirements, including duplicate copies of those serving at DMP as volunteers; i.e catechist. Training of additional facilitator(s) at the earliest is needed. We need to supply Karen with the names of those who have 2 days available for training during the summer period. Members from other dioceses, who have taken PGC already or are certified by their own diocese need to provide a letter of attestation that they are PGC certified, like a suitability letter for priests. The Archdiocese of Newark will provide the community with a list of all BLD members who are up to date with their assessment and are compliant with the mandate of the Charter. Karen Clark will provide Emil Canlas with a teaching material that can be utilized to teach our children how to protect themselves: ("Empowering God's Children", which is now being used in Catholic Schools) and share this with the teaching ministry. It can be taught by any of our teachers.

		Msgr. Schetelick's Coverage for LSS and other BLD retreats and seminars
		 Msgr. Schetelick is in the process of looking for priests who may be interested in serving as spiritual directors for LSS or any encounter weekend retreats. Msgr. Schetelick will give us the list of priests, who can be asked to serve when he is not available. They will be invited to attend the MEW, so that they will get to experience it and learn the movements. Msgr. Schetelick stated that any priest that is a representative of the Catholic Church can be a spiritual director.
		 BLD Newark 2020 Schedule of Major Events: Reviewed the events and dates that need a spiritual director with Msgr. Schetelick; no changes made Management Apostolate Stewards will also email the schedule to Aileen Ciocon on 5/22/19 According to Msgr. Schetelick, BLD Newark is the priority. Msgr. Schetelick is not available from May 20 to 31, 2020 (for pilgrimage). Msgr. Schetelick is not available sometime in June 2020 during the usual SPE schedule.
		 MLA New Initiative: "You're Invited Return to Cana" Purpose: to evangelize couples who are not sacramentally married Initial draft of the project proposal submitted by Ollie Felibrico – reviewed and the general concept approved by Msgr. Schetelick. Meeting will be set-up to discuss the logistics, retreat movements, resources, including canon law's impediments to Catholic marriage and any related issues.
2	Meeting with Fr. Alex Cruz (Discussions)	 Contract provisions regarding our usage of DMP rooms/facilities: Issue with Parish's calendar not in synch with BLD's calendar: Confirmed with Fr. Alex that all dates and room reservation requests for 2019, submitted by BLD Newark on November 2018 and approved by DMP are final; hence, they do not need to be reconfirmed. Action items: A BLD Newark representative will attend the Parish Quarterly Pastoral Meeting. As a new procedure, Secretariat will send the BLD schedule of events to Stephanie (DMP Secretary) on a quarterly basis. Ask Stephanie to check the accuracy of John Mejorada's email address in the meeting invite's distribution list. Ask Stephanie (DMP Secretary) to add Vino/Beth's email address to the distribution list.

		 New Lockbox for BLD Office & Library/Code Access: A new lockbox for the key to the BLD office and library has been purchased. This new lockbox has the same make and model as the lockbox being used for the key to the entrance door to the auditorium and school building. This will be installed as soon as the item is delivered. A temporary code can be made available (up to 4 hours only) to access the key in the new lockbox, if needed, for non-BLD use of the library.
		 Room related issues: Fr. Alex Cruz approved the use of one small air conditioning unit in the J6 room during Summer months. Youth closet (by the kitchen) – Issue with lights not working, possibly caused by water leak from the roof adjoining the auditorium and the school building. BLD will have the area checked and have the cost of repair estimated. Vino will speak with T. Boyie Huelgas for Diocese's contractor. Mark 10 (Room 101) unsafe flooring. Temporary fix: Fr. Alex will ask someone to put a carpet on the affected area. Permanent solution: to replace the flooring with linoleum. Library floor issue Fr. Alex will ask the DMP maintenance person to assess the floor condition and will advise the DCS of the next step.
		 DMP Parishioners' Use of the library per the provisions in our lease agreement: Permission will be obtained prior to use of the Library. The room must always be kept tidy.
		 Other: Request from Fr. Alex: Always keep all building entrances closed. Fr. Alex approved the installation of a mailbox at the back of the rectory.
