1	Oratio Imperata (Prayer for Deliverance from Calamities)	The Catholic Bishop's Conference of the Philippines has asked the faithful to say this prayer. In solidarity and trust in God, BLD Newark starting this Friday, February 21, will for 9 consecutive Fridays, say the Oratio Imperata after the Unity prayer and before the start of a Eucharist Celebration. And during our P&W, it will be recited at the end of the Supplication prayer. This is a prayer for divine help to stop the global public menace of the Corona virus.

2	Community Health Precautions	<ul> <li>BLD follows St. Paul's exhortation in Romans 16:16a and 1 Corinthians 16:20 in which he says, "Greet one another with a holy kiss." This has been a part of our custom and tradition here in BLD Newark, unfortunately due to ongoing epidemic of the N-CoV 19 virus, we encourage all members to take some precautions until this outbreak has been contained:</li> <li>Cover coughs and sneezes with tissue or sleeve, not your hands.</li> <li>Wash your hands often with soap and water. Use alcohol-based hand sanitizers if soap and water are not available.</li> <li>Avoid unnecessary physical contacts.</li> <li>Review and follow CDC travel advisories when planning travel. If you become ill after returning home to the United States, call your healthcare provider before going to a doctor's office or emergency department of a hospital. They may want to place a mask on you before you enter the building to protect other people.</li> <li>Follow good respiratory hygiene recommendations.</li> <li>Also, please be careful in spreading news from untrusted sources (e.g. news posted on Facebook) about this epidemic as some misinformation can cause undue fear and racial discrimination.</li> </ul>
