(Link will be provided to BLD members)</li> <li>The March for Life in Washington DC is cancelled for 2 reasons:</li> <li>First and foremost, the health and safety of BLD members who will join in the March for Life rally.</li> <li>There are no buses available to take the participants to Washington, DC</li> </ul>
