THEMES AND PROMISES

Week#1 (Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord)

Theme: We are led to the truth when we look to Jesus as our Redeemer.

Promise: "... you shall be radiant at what you see... the wealth of nations shall be

brought to you." (Is 60:5)

Order: "Rise up... the glory of the Lord shines upon you." (Is 60:1)

Direction/s:

Read God's word daily that you may see the truth in all things.

Visit Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament and offer yourself as a gift, ready to do His will.

Week#2 (2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time)

Theme: We are led to the truth when we make Christ known to others.

Promise: "Whoever is joined to the Lord becomes one Spirit with him."

(1Cor 6:17)

Order: "Behold, the Lamb of God." (Jn 1:36b)
Direction/s: Testify to the victory of Jesus in our lives.

Prophecies:

• Listen to My Word with sincerity and the Holy Spirit will come to you to instruct you in the heavenly ways of living in My kingdom so you can share in My divine life.

• Learn to recognize my voice amidst the noise and confusion of this age that you may stand firm in the truth.

Week#3 (3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time)

Theme: We are led to the truth when we respond to God's call to be followers of Christ. Promise: "...the Lord shows sinners the way... and teaches the humble his way."

(Ps 26:8b-9)

Order:

• "Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men." (Mk 1:17)

Direction/s:

Seek growth in discipleship by deepening your understanding and fulfilling your pledges.

• Focus on Jesus when you meet adversity and contradictions in community.

Week#4 (4th Sunday in Ordinary Time)

Theme: We are led to the truth when we speak God's word with authority.

Promise: "I will raise up for them a prophet... and will put my words into his mouth;

he shall tell them all that I command him." (Dt 18:18)

Order: "...Speak in my Name." (Dt 18:19)

Direction/s:

• Study God's Word that you may be able to proclaim the Gospel with authority.

• Invoke the name of Jesus when engaging in spiritual warfare.
