WORD, THEMES AND PROMISES For APRIL 2018

READINGS

COMMUNITY WORD: The resurrection of Jesus Christ strengthens our faith.

ORDER: "Live and declare the works of the Lord." (Psalm 118:17)

PROPHECIES:

Do not doubt My presence, for in my Resurrection, I will raise you up on the last day and give you Eternal Life.

DIRECTION:

> Be the Lord's witness, testifying to what Jesus has done in your life.

THEMES AND PROMISES

<u>Week#1 (Easter Sunday)</u>

Theme: Our faith is strengthened when we testify to Christ's resurrection.

Order: "Live and declare the works of the Lord." (Psalm 118:17)

Direction: Be the Lord's witness, testifying to what Jesus has done in your life.

Promise: "When Christ your life appears, then you, too, will appear with him in glory." (Colossians 3:4)

Week#2 (2nd Sunday of Easter)

Theme: Our faith is strengthened when we truly believe in Christ's presence in our midst. **Order**: "Do not be unbelieving, but believe." (John 20:27b)

Directions:

- Immerse yourselves, be inspired as you reflect on the Word.
- Avail of the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist.

Promise: "Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed." (John 20:29b)

Week#3 (3rd Sunday of Easter)

Theme: Our faith is strengthened when we open our hearts and minds to God's word. **Order**: *"Repent, therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be wiped away."* (Acts 3:19) **Directions**:

- Avail of the sacrament of reconciliation regularly or as frequently as possible.
- Prepare with a good examination of conscience.

Promise: "... whoever keeps his word the love of God is truly perfected in him." (1 John 2:5)

Week#4 (4th Sunday of Easter)

Theme: Our faith is strengthened when we serve others in self-giving sacrifice.

Order: "Lay down your life for your sheep." (John 10:11b paraphrased)

Directions:

- Be an instrument to bring others to Jesus.
- Witness to the gospel by serving in your ministry without counting the cost.
- Be willing to serve in the community beyond your comfort zone.

Promise: "... we are God's children now; what shall be revealed is ... we shall be like him, for we shall see him as he is." (1 John 3:2)

Week#5 (5th Sunday of Easter)

Theme: Our faith is strengthened when we bear much fruit for God's kingdom.

Order: "Bear much fruit and become my disciples." (John 15:8)

Directions:

- Love one another not in word or speech, but in deed and in truth.
- Meditate on the Word of God regularly and do as He tells you.

Promise: "If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask for whatever you want and it will be done for you." (John 15:7)
