Week#4 (Solemnity of the Holy Trinity)

Promise: "...the Spirit of truth will guide you..." (Jn 16:13a)

Order: Boast in hope of the glory of God.

Directions:

• Do everything for God's glory. Praise His Holy Name.

• Do not seek human recognition for your good works.

Pray unceasingly for your needs and for guidance from the Holy Spirit.

Week#5 (Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ)

Theme: We keep the word of God when we share our blessings, remembering Jesus in the Eucharist.

Promise: "Yours is power in the day of your birth." (Ps 110:3a)

Order: Give them some food yourselves.

Directions:

- Partake of the Eucharist as often as you can.
- Encourage members to attend community teachings and retreats.
- Serve in your parish.
