Order: "walk by faith, not by sight... aspire to please him." 2 Cor 5: 7,9

Directions: Soak ourselves in daily Scripture readings and avail of the sacraments.

Serve others and bear witness to your faith.

Promise: "They that are planted in the Lord ...shall bear fruit even in old age;

vigorous and sturdy shall they be." (Ps 92: 14, 15)

Week#3 – 6/18:20 (12th Sunday of Ordinary Time)

Theme: Our life is sustained for eternal redemption when we trust Jesus to calm the

storms in our life.

Order: "Be still! ...have faith." Mk 4:39-40.

Direction: Believe and Hold on to God's promises in all of life's circumstances.

Promise: "They cried to the Lord in their distress... he rescued them." (Ps

107:28)

Week#4 - 6/25:27 (13th Sunday of Ordinary Time)

Theme: Our life is sustained for eternal redemption when we acknowledge the

healing grace of Jesus.

Order: "Do not be afraid, just have faith." Mk 5:36b

Directions: ◆ Pray unceasingly in all circumstances.

• In expectant faith, claim God's healing grace.
