COMMUNITY WORD

Jesus, the Bread of Life, answers the needs of those who heed him.

ORDER:

"Come... listen that you may have life." (Is 55:3a)

PROPHECIES:

- 1. I am the Bread of Life who brings joy and restores fullness of mind, body and spirit.
- 2. Heed Me, I speak in the silence in your heart.

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Share the blessings you receive from God to others; comfort them in their grief and help them in their need.
- 2. Kneel and pray in times of struggle and offer your pains to the Lord; take courage and trust in Him.

THEMES AND PROMISES

Week#1 - (18th Sunday in Ordinary Time)

Theme: We heed Jesus when we are compassionate and generous in sharing our

blessings to others.

Order: "...give them some food yourselves." (Mt 14:16b)

<u>Directions:</u> Participate in virtual word-sharing circles.

Donate food & supplies to community soup kitchen or your parish food drive.

Promise: "Heed me, and you shall eat well, you shall delight in rich fare." (Is 55:2b)

Week#2 - (19th Sunday in Ordinary Time)

Theme: We heed Jesus when we take courage and put our trust in Him.

Order: "...do not be afraid." (Mt 14:27b)

Direction: Pray at all times, offer your fears and sufferings to the Lord.

<u>Promise:</u> "The Lord himself shall walk before him and prepare the way of his steps."

(Ps 85:13a, 4)

Week#3 - (20th Sunday in Ordinary Time)

Theme: We heed Jesus when we possess an unwavering faith in His mercy.

Order: "Observe what is right, do what is just." (Is 56:1a)

Direction: Persevere and be faithful in prayer.

<u>Promise:</u> "Great is your faith! Let it be done as you wish." (Mt 15:28)

Week#4 - (21st Sunday in Ordinary Time)

<u>Theme:</u> We heed Jesus when we proclaim Him, Son of the Living God.

Order: "Whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on

earth shall be loosed in heaven." (Mt 16:19)

Directions: Exercise authority with meekness and humility.

Proclaim boldly in words and deeds that Jesus Christ is Lord.

<u>Promise:</u> "...upon this rock I will build my church, and the gates of the netherworld shall

not prevail against it." (Mt 16:18)

Week#5 - (22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time)

Theme: We heed Jesus when we do not conform ourselves to the ways of the world.

Order: "...offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God." (Rom 12:1)

<u>Directions:</u> Stand firm in your Catholic faith and beliefs.

Live your life in continuous worship of the Lord.

<u>Promise:</u> "...whoever loses his life for my sake will find it." (Mt 16:25b)
