THEMES AND PROMISES

Week#1 (22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time) - Worship Date: August 31 based on Readings for September 2nd

Readings: Dt 4:1,2,6-8/Ps 15:2-5/Jas 1:17,18,21,22,27/Mk 7:1-8,14,15,21-23

<u>Theme:</u> There is peace in our hearts when we confess our sins.

Order: "Be doers of the word and not hearers only" (Jas1:22a) Directions:

- 1) Faithfully go to Jesus in the Sacrament of Reconciliation and receive Him in the Holy Eucharist.
- 2) Evangelize by being good witnesses and be active in mission works.

<u>Promise:</u> "Whoever walks blamelessly and does justice; who thinks the truth in his heart ... shall never be disturbed." (Ps 15:2-3,5)

Week#2 (23rdSunday in Ordinary Time) - September 7th (BLD First Friday Eucharistic Celebration)

Readings: Is 35:4-7/Ps 146:7-10/Jas 2:1-5/Mk 7:31-37

<u>Theme:</u> There is peace in our hearts when we are open to God's saving power.

Order: "...Be strong, fear not!" (Is 35:4a)

Direction:

Be bold in proclaiming and practicing your faith.

Promise: "Here is your God... he comes to save you." (Is 35:4b)

Week#3 (24thSunday in Ordinary Time) - Worship Date: September 14th based on Readings for Sept 16th

Readings: Is 50:5-9/Ps 116:1-6, 8, 9/Jas 2:14-18/Mk 8:27-35

Theme: There is peace in our hearts when we deny ourselves to follow Christ.

Order: "...Take up his cross, and follow me." (Mk 8:34b)

Direction:

- 1) Do corporal works of mercy.
- 2) Willingly offer yourself in the service of the Lord by your humble acceptance of ministry assignments.

<u>Promise:</u> "Whoever loses his life for my sake and that of the gospel will save it." (Mk 8:35b)

Week#4 (25thSunday in Ordinary Time) - Worship Date: September 21st based on Readings for Sept 23rd

Readings: Wis 2:12, 17-20/Ps 84:3, 4, 5, 6, 8/Jas 3:16-4:3/Mk 9:30-37

<u>Theme:</u> There is peace in our hearts when we surrender our selfish ambition for the sake of the gospel.

Order: "...Be the last of all and the servant of all" (Mk 9:35b) Direction:

- 1) Humbly regard others as more important than yourself.
- 2) Serve in your ministry with love and humility.

<u>Promise:</u> "God is my helper; the Lord sustains my life." (Ps 54:4)

Week#5 (26th Sunday in Ordinary Time) - Worship Date: September 28th based on Readings for Sept 30th

Readings: Nm 11:25-29/Ps 19:8, 10, 12, 13, 14/Jas 5:1-6/Mk 9:38-43, 45, 47,48 Theme: There is peace in our hearts when we do not allow sin to separate us from the love of God.

Order: "...Be blameless and innocent of serious sin." (Ps 19:14b) Direction:

- 1) Do frequent examination of conscience and receive the sacrament of reconciliation.
- 2) Let not our words and actions cause others to sin.
- 3) Be open to receive fraternal correction.

<u>Promise:</u> "... because you belong to Christ ...you will surely not lose his reward." (Mk 9:41)
