COMMUNITY WORD:

Jesus our Sovereign King is our hope of glory.

ORDER:

"...direct your hearts to the love of God and to the endurance of Christ..." (2 Thes 3:5)

PROPHECIES:

1. I will fill your heart with My Spirit and give you the boldness to seek and save the lost.
2. Ponder how much I love you. I am the King and Lord of the universe, but My cross is the fount of mercy.

THEMES AND PROMISES

Week#1 (31st Sunday in Ordinary Time) November 3rd (BLD First Friday Eucharistic Celebration)

Theme: Our hope of glory is in Jesus our King when we repent and make reparation for our sins.

Order: "... *Have mercy on all...*" (Wis 11:23)

Directions:

1. Pray and reach out those who are struggling in life and lead them to Jesus.
2. Repent of your wrongdoing and make reparations to those you have offended.

Promise: "*The Lord lifts up all who are falling and raises up all who are bowed down.*"

(Ps 145:14)

Week#2 (32nd Sunday in Ordinary Time) November 10th

Theme: Our hope of glory is in Jesus our King when we patiently endure our sufferings for the Kingdom.

Order: "... *direct your hearts to the love of God and to the endurance of Christ.*" (2 Thes 3:5)

Directions:

1. Endure trials and stay steadfast in your spiritual walk.
2. Give hope to those who are going through difficulties.

Promise: "... *the Lord is faithful; he will strengthen you and guard you from the evil one.*"

(2 Thes 3:3)

Week#3 (33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time) November 17th

Theme: Our hope of glory is in Jesus our King when we persevere in our faith.

Order: "... *See that you not be deceived, for many will come in my name... Do not follow them.*"

(Lk 21:8)

Directions:

1. Do not conform to the ways of the world.
2. Keep busy, stay focused on doing your ministry work.

Promise: "*By your perseverance you will secure your lives.*" (Lk 21:19)

Week#4 (The Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe) November 24th

Theme: Our hope of glory is in Jesus our King when we believe in the promise of eternal life.

Order: "... *share in the inheritance of the holy ones in light.*" (Col 1:12)

Directions:

1. Go to confession on a regular basis.
2. Praise and worship the Lord at all times.

Promise: "... *you will be with me in Paradise.*" (Lk 22:43)

“But the hour is coming, and is now here, when true worshippers will worship the Father in Spirit and truth; and indeed the Father seeks such people to worship him. God is Spirit, and those who worship him must worship in Spirit and in truth.” (John 4:23-24)
