# Week#2 (32nd Sunday in Ordinary Time) - First Friday Eucharistic Celebration on Nov. 6

**Theme:** We are sanctified when we are vigilant in witnessing to our faith.

Order: "Stay awake, for you know neither the day nor the hour." (Mt 25:13)

**Directions:** 

- 1. Confess and receive forgiveness, turn away from all wrongdoings.
- 2. Receive communion as often as possible so you can stay vigilant.

Promise: "We who are alive...shall always be with the Lord." (1 Thes 4:17)

# Week#3 (33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time) - Praise and Worship on Nov. 13

Theme: We are sanctified when we make good use of our gifts and talents for God's glory.

Order: "Since you were faithful in small matters, I will give you great responsibilities.

Come, share your master's joy." (Mt 25:23b)

#### **Directions:**

- 1. Allow the Holy Spirit to lead and help you grow in all areas of your gifting.
- 2. Maximize the use of your talents by accepting new roles in serving His vineyard.

Promise: "...to everyone who has, more will be given and he will grow rich..." (Mt 25:29a)

## Week#4 (Solemnity of Christ the King) - Praise and Worship on Nov. 20

**Theme:** We are sanctified when we render works of mercy.

Order: "...do for one of these least ones..." (Mt 25:45b)

#### **Directions:**

- 1. Pray to God to have courage and strength to help the least and the lost.
- 2. Do corporal works of mercy.

Promise: "Come, you who are blessed by my Father. Inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world." (Mt. 25:34).
