Week#1 (1st Sunday of Advent) - Worship Date: November 30 based on readings for Dec. 2.

Readings: Jer 33:14-16/Ps 25:4-5, 8-9,10,14/1Thes 3:12-4:2/Lk 21:25-28, 34-36

Theme: We prepare for Christ's coming when we persevere in doing what is right and just.

Order: "Be vigilant at all times and pray..." (Lk 21:36)

#### **Direction:**

- 1. Pray persistently, go to confession and receive Holy Communion regularly.
- 2. Do charitable works and share your blessings during the Season of Joy.

**Promise:** "Good and upright is the Lord; thus he shows sinners the way." (Ps 25:8)

Week#2 (2nd Sunday of Advent) – December 7 (BLD First Friday Eucharistic Celebration)

Readings: Bar 51-9/Ps 126:1-2, 2-3,4-5,6/Phil 1:4-6,8-11/Lk 3:1-6

**Theme:** We prepare for Christ's coming when we repent of our wrongdoings and seek forgiveness.

## Order: "Discern what is of value so that you may be pure and blameless for the day of *Christ.*" (Phil. 1: 10b)

#### **Direction:**

- 1. Look deep into your soul and avail of the sacrament of Reconciliation to be cleansed of every impurity.
- 2. Remain shielded from evil forces through your regular faith-filled prayers.

Promise: "...the one who began a good work in you will continue to complete it until the day of Christ Jesus." (Phil 1:6)

Week#3 (3rd Sunday of Advent) – Worship Date: December 14, based on readings for Dec. 16.

**Readings:** Zep 3:14-18/Is 12:2-3, 4, 5-6/Phil 4:4-7/Lk 3:10-18

**Theme:** We prepare for Christ's coming when we gladly share our blessings with others.

Order: *"Rejoice in the Lord always... your kindness should be known to all."* (Phil 4:4)

#### **Direction:**

- 1. Have no anxiety at all and do not fear sharing what you have.
- 2. Do corporal works of mercy.

## Promise: "The peace of God that surpasses all understanding will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus." (Phil 4:7)

Week#4 (4th Sunday of Advent) - Worship Date: December 21, based on readings for Dec. 23.

Readings: Mi 5:1-4/Ps 80:2-3,5-16,18-19/Heb 10:5-10/Lk 1:39-45

**Theme:** We prepare for Christ's coming when we accept and obey the will of God in our lives.

Order: "Stand firm and shepherd His flock by the strength of the Lord." (Mi 5:3)

**Direction:** 

- 1. Proclaim the Good News in your words and in your actions at all times.
- 2. Partake of the body of Christ in memory of His sacrifice.

# Promise: "Blessed are you who believed that what was spoken to you by the Lord would be fulfilled." (Lk 1:45)

Week#5 (Feast of the Holy Family) – Worship Date: December 28, based on readings for Dec. 30.

Readings: Sir 3:2-6, 12-14/Ps 128:1-2, 3, 4-5/Col 3:12-21/Lk 2:41-52

**Theme:** We prepare for Christ's coming when we let God be the center of our family life.

Order: "...whatever you do, in word or in deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus." (Col 3:17)

### **Direction:**

- 1. Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, as in all wisdom you teach and admonish one another.
- 2. Wives, be subordinate to your husbands...Husbands, love your wives...Children, obey your parents in everything...Fathers, do not provoke your children...

# **Promise:** *"For you shall eat the fruit of your handiwork, blessed shall you be and favored."* (Ps 128:2)
