- 2. Do daily readings, reflections and living the Word of God.
- 3. Seek and develop spiritual gifts that will equip us for the works of ministry.

Promise: "He will keep you firm to the end, irreproachable on the day of our Lord Jesus Christ." (1 Cor 1:8)

## Week#2 (2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of Advent) - First Friday Eucharistic Celebration on Dec. 4

Theme: We prepare for Christ's coming when we humbly acknowledge our sins and repent.

Order: "Prepare the way of the Lord." (Mk 1:3)

#### Direction:

1. Reconcile with God and others.

Promise: "...according to his promise we await new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells." (2 Pt 3:13)

# Week#3 (3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of Advent) - Praise and Worship on Dec. 11 by Solo Parents

**Theme:** We prepare for Christ's coming when we testify that Jesus is our Light and Salvation.

Order: "Rejoice always. Pray without ceasing. In all circumstances give thanks." (1 Thes 5:16-18)

### **Directions:**

- 1. Read daily scriptures, reflect and prepare for the coming of our Lord.
- 2. Do acts of love and kindness by sharing with those in need, as a perfect gift to Jesus.
- 3. Invite others to attend teachings, nightly prayers and praise & worships.

Promise: "He has mercy on those who fear him in every generation." (Lk 1:50)

## Week#4 (4th Sunday of Advent) - Community Praise and Worship on Dec. 18

**Theme:** We prepare for Christ's coming when we submit to the Will of the Father.

Order: "Do not be afraid." (Lk 1:30)

### **Directions:**

- 1. Be steadfast with our faith and ask God to transform our hearts of love, meekness and thanksgiving.
- 2. Ask the Holy Spirit to come upon us and submit ourselves to God's plan and will for us.
- 3. Be a messenger of God's love by sharing words of encouragement and performing charitable acts of mercy.

Promise: "I will be a father to him, and he shall be a son to me." (2 Sam 7:14a)

## Week#5 (Feast of the Holy Family) - Christmas Day - NO WORSHIP on Dec. 25

**Theme:** We prepare for Christ's coming when we foster Christian values in our family and community.

Order: "Put on, as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, heartfelt compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience, bearing with one another and forgiving one another." (Col 3:12-13a)

#### **Directions:**

- 1. Wives, be subordinate to your husbands...Husbands, love your wives...
- 2. Children, obey your parents in everything...
- 3. Parents, do not provoke your children...

Promise: "Blessed is everyone who fears the Lord, who walks in his ways! For you shall eat the fruit of your handiwork." (Psalm 128:1,2a)
